

UCR GRADING SCALES

The University of California, Riverside, has the following grade options:

A+	A	A-
B+	B	B-
C+	C	C-
D+	D	D-

S (satisfactory)

NC (no credit)

Per Riverside Division Academic Senate Regulation R1.1.1 "...The grade A+ carries 4.0 grade points per unit, the same as for an unsuffixed A; but when A+ is reported, it represents extraordinary achievement."

If "SN" appears next to a student's name on the course roster, the following scale should be used to determine whether the student has earned an "S" or an "NC" grade:

	Graduate Student	Undergraduate Student
"S" grade	"B"–3.0 or higher	"C"–2.0 or higher
"NC" grade	Anything below a 3.0	Anything below a 2.0

"I" (incomplete) grades are assigned only to those students whose work is incomplete for good cause

"IP" (in-progress) grades are assigned only for classes extending more than one quarter
